第十三屆「臺灣好精彩!」圖文攝影暨短片大賽

比賽辦法

一、活動主旨:

希望以外籍學生的角度,將臺灣深厚多元的文化、人情、美景,透過影片、相片及文字,交織出驚嘆與感動,呈現臺灣不一樣的精彩面貌。並期盼藉此活動,鼓勵外國學生深入接觸臺灣在地文化,進而向世界推廣臺灣。

二、活動主題:

「記憶臺灣」:用影像及圖像記錄臺灣的美好,從自然景觀到人文故事,每一刻都展現臺灣的獨特魅力。

三、活動對象:

臺灣獎學金及華語文獎學金之在領受獎學生。

四、比賽辦法:

(一) 圖文組

- 1. 攝影器材:無限制,專業相機、數位相機、平板電腦、手機皆可。
- 作品呈現:自訂題目,同一題目以四張照片呈現,並搭配文字敘述,文字 需中英對照,中文需約50~100字。
- 3. 照片內容:主題不限,舉凡參賽者覺得新奇有趣的臺灣景色、民俗節慶、 人文風土、產業文化、建築文物、自然景觀等,皆可拍攝。
- 4. 文字內容:敘述關於照片的故事及個人感受。
- 5. 請勿翻拍、拷貝、盜用、人工加色、電腦合成,照片僅可適度調整亮度、對比度,及色彩飽和度。
- 6. 作品原檔應為 JPEG 格式,檔案大小應在 5MB 以內,解析度 600 萬畫素以上。
- 7. 曾參加其他攝影比賽得獎、或曾公開發表(如平面出版、公開展覽等)之作品不得參賽。參賽者保證其參賽作品為本人原創、合法之攝影作品,絕無侵害任何第三人或法人之智慧財產權、隱私權、 肖像權及其他權利之情事,因此所衍生之法律問題,概由參賽者自行負責。
- 8. 檔案格式不完整以致無法讀取,而影響評選結果將以棄權論,不另行通知。
- 9. 獲獎作品之數位原始檔案著作財產權歸主辦單位所有。
- 10. 作品評選方式與標準:

評選方式:初審評選佳作二十三名,再複審選出前三名。

評選標準:照片構圖 40%、文字內容 40%、整體創意 20%。

評審組成:教育部、外交部代表各一位、專業人士三位。

- 12. 獲獎作品將於「2025 年臺灣獎學金及華語文獎學金畢結業生歡送會」活動現場展覽。
- 13. 前三名獲獎者需配合主辦單位安排拍攝得獎影片。
- 14. 主辦單位將於展覽當天,於臺上頒發前三名得獎者之獎金及獎狀。其他得獎者,可於活動當日或他 日領取獎金及獎狀。

(二) 短片組

- 1. 攝影器材:無限制,專業攝錄影機、數位相機、平板電腦、手機皆可。
- 2. 作品呈現:**影片長度應在2分鐘以內**(包含:片頭、主題內容、片尾卡司介紹等),逾2分鐘之影片, 將取消競賽資格不另通知。
- 3. 影片內容:主題不限,舉凡參賽者覺得新奇有趣的臺灣景色、民俗節慶、人文風土、產業文化、建築 文物、自然景觀等,皆可拍攝。
- 4. 影片需為 MOV 或 MP4 檔案格式,輸出比例為 16:9,影片解析度為 1280X720(720p)(含)以上,如達 1920X1080 (1080p)尤佳。
- 5. 曾參加其他比賽得獎、或曾公開發表(如數位出版、公開展覽等)之作品不得參賽。參賽者保證其 參賽作品為本人原創、合法之作品,絕無侵害任何第三人或法人之智慧財產權、隱私權、肖像權及 其他權利之情事,因此所衍生之法律問題,概由參賽者自行負責。若引用音樂超過合理引用之長度及 範圍,請提供事先取得之著作權所有人使用同意書。

評選方式:評選前三名作品。

評選標準:影片主題 40%、劇情與創意 40%、原創性 20%。

評審組成:教育部、外交部代表各一位、專業人士三位。

Photography and Short Film Contest Regulations

I. Activity Goal

It is hoped that from the perspective of foreign students, Taiwan's deep and diverse culture, humanity and beauty will be interwoven with photos and texts to express surprises and emotions and present Taiwan's different wonderful faces. We look forward to this activity, which will encourage foreign students to get in touch with the local culture of Taiwan and promote Taiwan to the world.

II. Activity Theme

Memories of Taiwan: A celebration of Taiwan's beauty through images and visuals, capturing its breathtaking landscapes and heartfelt human stories. Every moment reflects the island's unique and captivating charm.

III. Participants

The current Taiwan Scholarship and Huayu Enrichment Scholarship recipients.

IV. Contest Method

A. For Photographs and Captions

1. Equipment

No limit. From professional cameras to digital cameras, tablet computers, and mobile phones.

2. Presentation

Works should be presented in the form of a set of 4 photos with a short caption of 50 to 100 words in Chinese and translate your caption into English.

3. Photograph content

The theme is not limited. For example, participants who find novel and interesting Taiwan scenery, folk festivals, humanities and culture, industrial culture, architectural relics, natural landscapes, etc. are all accepted.

4. Text content

It should be a set of 4 photos to describe the story and the participant's personal feelings.

- 5. Please do not use copied, photocopied, copyrighted, touched-up, or computer-generated photos. Only moderate adjustments to brightness and color contrast saturation are allowed.
- 6. A single image file should be limited to 5MB in JPEG format for the original photos. Entry resolution should be more than 6 megapixels for exporting files to the exhibition.

- 7. Photographs that have won prizes in other photo contests or have been published are not eligible for submission. The entries must be the original and legal work of the contestants and non-infringing of the rights of others. Contestants are responsible for the resolution of any legal issues arising from their works.
- 8. Entries that are unreadable due to incomplete file format will be withdrawn from the contest without notification.
- 9. Property rights to the original digital files of winning entries belong to the organizer.
- 10. Work evaluation method and criteria:

Evaluation method: The preliminary review will select 23 honorable mentions, and the secondary review will select the top three prizes.

Evaluation criteria: composition 40%, content 40%, creativity 20%.

Judge composition: One representative from the Ministry of Education, and Ministry of Foreign Affairs each, with three professional experts.

- 11. Web voting will be held on the "臺灣獎學金及華語文獎學金計畫 Taiwan Scholarship and Huayu Enrichment Scholarship Program" Facebook fan page, with an additional Crowd Favorite award.
 - ♦ The online voting event will conduct IP address tracking, and upon investigation, if individuals engaging in duplicate voting are identified, their eligibility for this competition will be canceled.
- 12. The awarded works will be exhibited at the "2025 Taiwan Scholarship and Huayu Enrichment Scholarship Recipients Farewell Party"
- 13. The top three winners are required to cooperate with the organizers in arranging the filming of award-winning videos.
- 14. Top three winners can get prizes and awards on stage on exhibition day. Other winners can get prizes and awards on exhibition day or another day.

B. For Short Film

1. Equipment

No limit. From professional cameras to digital cameras, tablet computers, and mobile phones.

2. Presentation

The length of the film should be less than 2 minutes (including the title, content, credits scene, etc.). If the film exceeds 2 minutes, it will be disqualified without further notice.

3. Film content

The theme is not limited. For example, participants who find novel and interesting Taiwan scenery, folk festivals, humanities and culture, industrial culture, architectural relics, natural landscapes, etc. are all accepted.

4. The entry must be in MOV or MP4 file format, the output ratio must be 16: 9,

- and the video resolution must be above 1280X720 (720p) (inclusive), it'll be better if it is 1920X1080 (1080p).
- 5. Entries that have won prizes in other competitions or have been published publicly (such as digital publishing, public exhibitions, etc.) are not allowed to participate. Participants guarantee that their entries are original and legal works, and will not infringe on the intellectual property rights, privacy rights, portrait rights, and other rights of any third party or legal person. Therefore, the contestants are responsible for all the legal issues. Please provide the copyright owner's consent to use it in advance if the quoted music exceeds the scope of reasonable citations.
- 6. Entries that are unreadable due to incomplete file format will be withdrawn from the contest without notification.
- 7. Property rights to the original digital files of winning entries belong to the organizer.
- 8. Work evaluation method and criteria: Evaluation method: A preliminary review will select the Top 3 prizes. Evaluation criteria: theme 40%, plot and creativity 40%, originality 20%. Judge composition: One representative from the Ministry of Education, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and Ministry of Science and Technology each,
- 9. The awarded works will be uploaded to the "臺灣獎學金及華語文獎學金計畫 Taiwan Scholarship and Huayu Enrichment Scholarship Program" Facebook fan page and played at "2025 Taiwan Scholarship and Huayu Enrichment Scholarship Recipients Farewell Party".
- 10. The Top 3 award winners can get prizes and awards on stage on the exhibition day.

- vi. Each person can submit a maximum of 2 entries per category.
